# Background

- The Louth/Meath county boundary lines around Drogheda are not beneficial to local families that require HSE and other services for that county.
- Families from Drogheda designated as having an address in Meath must travel to Navan, Duleek etc. for certain services. This is not acceptable.
- We live in a housing Estate (Highlands) and it is Designated Co. Meath. The estate across the Road is Riverbank and the village across the Boyne River (Tullyallen) is designated in Co. Meath.

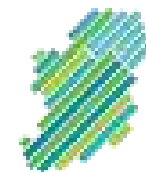

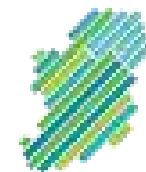


# Proposal
