Letter: Greetings,

I have just signed a petition to put a walking and cycling path for everyone to enjoy parallel with Kiltimagh Velorail. The velorail project is welcome and it is good to see investment in the closed railway as we all know the railway is never going to re-open, however in order that this is not exclusively a pay per use facility and is available in particular for locals to use freely we ask that a parallel path is put in place so the route can double up as velorail and greenway. 284 submissions on the most recent county plan asked for a greenway on this route; the views of those submissions need to be respected.
