The Transition Galway 2030 Vision document is available in pdf form at https://avisionforgalway2030.files.wordpress.com/2015/12/vd-bookleta4interactive.pdf.

In April, 2013 Transition Galway hosted the 'Galway Visioning Day' at a local school. The event was launched by the Mayor of Galway City and was an opportunity for the public to share their ideas to create a plan for a low-carbon, sustainable Galway City by the year 2030. Similar plans have been produced for Kinsale, Co. Cork, Totnes in England and many other places around the world.

Phase two of the process happened between March and May 2014, when the group invited the people of Galway to a series of open, free, public visioning events.

The booklet was released in November 2015 and the Mayor and President of the Galway Chamber of Commerce were invited speakers at the event. The launch was also covered on Irish TV, the Irish Times and a number of other news sources.

The contents can also be accessed via the website https://avisionforgalway2030.wordpress.com. The website also features a series of films summarising each of the 8 sections.

In each section of the document there is first an explanation of the challenges we face. Also the subheading of each solution outlines which organisations or groups are seen as the change makers to implement that solution.

We hope that this document will in some way go towards creating a better, more resilient Galway and Ireland by 2030. The ideas in the document transposed to many locations and indeed many of the ideas are at National rather than regional level which require Government support to implement.
